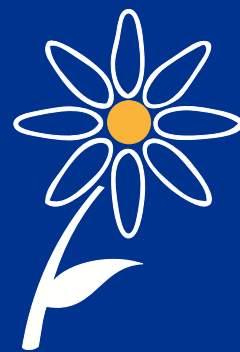

## I Love South Yorkshire - Supporters Pack



The South Yorkshire Community Foundation helps improve the lives of local people living in disadvantaged communities. We work with individuals, businesses, philanthropists, trusts and statutory bodies to support communities to tackle important local issues.

### I Love South Yorkshire:

'I Love' is a campaign run by SYCF to encourage people to work together to tackle the issues that matter most in local communities.

You can support the causes that matter most in your area, as there are separate 'I Love' campaigns for **Barnsley, Doncaster, Rotherham, Sheffield** and **South Yorkshire**.

### Official Partner:

Businesses or organisations can make an annual donation of £1,000 (£84 a month) to become an official partner in our charitable work. You will be putting something back and helping to tackle important issues in your area .

### Official Supporter:

Don't worry if your business doesn't have £1,000 available, **you can still support the 'I Love' campaign** by organising a series of fundraising events. If your fundraising hits the £1,000 target you will be made an **Official Partner** of the campaign.

### Individual Supporter:

If you are an individual and want to show your love for the area you can also get involved with the 'I Love' campaign. With a charitable donation (suggested £10 a month) to one of our geographical 'community funds' you can help us make a difference in your area.

### Donations:

If you are a business you can offset your donation against corporation tax. We will reclaim gift aid on donations from eligible individuals. Donations will be used for immediate grant making in local communities, to support the ongoing charitable work of SYCF, to connect organisations to community and voluntary projects and to match the donated resources to communities that require support. All donations are 100% charitable.

## How you can get involved

People can support the campaign using a whole range of methods, below are just a few examples.

### Donate:

#### Set up a monthly standing order

We encourage supporters to set up monthly standing orders of £10+ a month

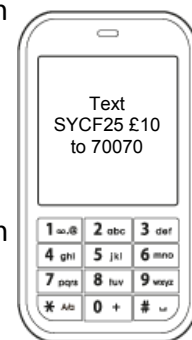
It is safe for us to provide this information as these accounts only allow payments in, which reduces risk.

#### Donate by text

Text the special code 'SYCF25' followed by the amount you want to give to 70070.

For example text 'SYCF25' followed by £10 to 70070 to make a donation to SYCF.

Alternatively you can also donate to your specific geographical area by replacing SYCF25 with BARN25, DONC25, ROTH25 or SHEF25



### Fundraise:

#### Organise fundraising day(s) at work

- Organise a monthly dress up/down day at work to raise vital funds to tackle local issues
- Hold a bake sale - 'I Love' themed cakes
- Hold a lunchtime pub style quiz. Teams pay to enter; the quiz could be based on facts about your area.
- Turn the air Red, instead of Blue: If someone in your office swears too much then encourage them to start a swear box with the proceeds being donated to the 'I Love' Campaign.

It can help to focus your fundraising on a specific date or set of dates. Here are some suggestions:

**'I Love' Day** – 14<sup>th</sup> February – what better way to show your love for the area than organising some fundraising on Valentine's Day (or the closest suitable day)

**Yorkshire Day** – 1<sup>st</sup> August – help dispel the myth that Yorkshire Folk are tight by raising money on Yorkshire Day (or the closest date that is suitable to your organisation). Celebrate and represent Yorkshire as you see it, dress up or dress down, hold a competition to see who knows the most 'Yorkshire Phrases', organise a Yorkshire themed lunch with pie and peas or Yorkshire Puds. It's about having a laugh and raising money to tackle local issues!

If your organisation is having an annual dinner or awards ceremony you could ask suppliers to donate raffle or auction prizes which you could use to raise money to support the I Love Campaign.

JCI Sheffield organised a football tournament. Around 200 people took part and they raised more than £4,500. You could organise an 'inter area' tournament where teams from Barnsley, Doncaster, Rotherham & Sheffield compete to see who is best at Football and who can raise the most money to show their love for the area.
